

- **We have identified specific goals relevant to each environmental resource.**


PHASE III: TACTICAL

HOW WILL WE GET THERE?


Further Investigation – Based on the data collected in Phase I, conduct a Data Gap Analysis to determine what additional information is needed.

Establish Priorities:

- Step 1: Identify Impairments – What is keeping us from reaching our goal?
- Step 2: Identify the likely cause(s) of each impairment and determine its relative impact.



- Step 3: Determine the Cost Effectiveness of each solution.
- Step 4: Prioritize Resources
