Dear Mr. Kirk:

This is to invite the National Association of Clean Water Agencies (NACWA) to participate in the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) and Peak Wet Weather Discharge Workshop on July 14-15, 2011 in the Washington, DC area. We are interested in your organization's perspectives on potential options for modifying the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) regulations to define more specific permit requirements for addressing SSOs and the issue of peak flows at wastewater treatment facilities. For the workshop, we request that NACWA be represented by up to two (2) people of your choosing.

EPA is holding this workshop as a follow up to the listening sessions that were held in June and July of 2010. We received extensive verbal and written comments during and as a result of the listening sessions. As EPA evaluates options for modifying its regulations to address SSOs and peak wet weather discharges, the feedback we received from these listening sessions will continue to be very valuable. As a next step, EPA will hold a follow-up workshop in order to allow us and representatives of your organization to discuss these issues in greater detail.


