How to Prepare, What to Expect and Tips for the Event

Before the Webinar

- **Run the diagnostic test.** If this is your first online Adobe Connect meeting with EPA, run the test at [this link](#) . If you fail any portion of the test, please follow the instructions to resolve your problem. If you cannot resolve an issue, contact your local IT support.
- **Make sure your internal computer speakers are working, or you have headphones available.** All webinar audio will come from your computer, not a phone line.
- **Sign into the webinar using the link to the right.** You can log in from any computer with internet access. There are also free apps for tablets and smartphones.
- **Enter as a guest.** Then, identify yourself by supplying your **full name**. Upon entering this information, click the button to “Enter Meeting.”

During the Webinar

- **Sit back and watch the presentation.** The presentation slides will automatically change.
- **Ask questions.** Ask them at any time via the Q&A pod on the right side of the screen. Questions will only go to the moderator. Once they’re answered, they may be displayed to the group. We’ll also have specific time for Q&As, but we may pause at any time to answer questions.
- **Ask for help (if necessary).** Having tech problems? Get help via the Q&A pod!
