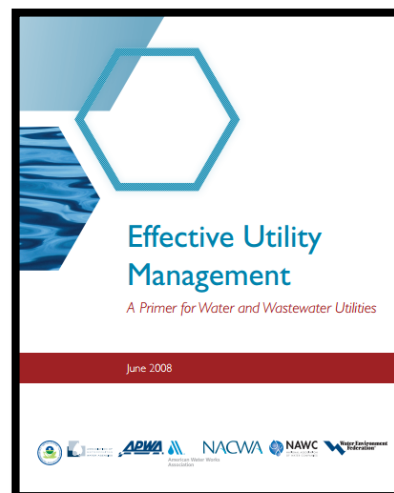


EFFECTIVE UTILITY MANAGEMENT REVIEW
