Mark Philbrick is the technical coordinator for the Water-Energy Technology Team at the Department of Energy (DOE). He was one of the primary authors of the DOE's recent report, *The Water-Energy Nexus: Challenges and Opportunities*. Working together with the Environmental Protection Agency and the National Science Foundation, the DOE is sponsoring a series of workshops on the theme of "energy-positive water resource recovery facilities", and expects to produce a summary document in late 2015 or early 2016. He is also working with the DOE's Bioenergy Technologies Office on their emerging waste-to-energy program.

Mr. Philbrick has a PhD in Environmental Science and Policy from the University of California, Berkeley, and was an American Association of Science Fellow at the DOE from 2011-2013.
