### States

#### ***Alabama***

Credits Approved: 17.3 Credits, Including 1.0 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the Alabama State Bar MCLE Board after the *Seminar*.

#### ***Alaska***

Credits Approved: 20.8 Credits, Including 1.2 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with West Virginia)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Alaska CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

#### ***Arizona***

Credits Approved: The State Bar of Arizona does not approve or accredit CLE Activity for the MCLE Requirement. This activity may qualify for up to 20.8 Credits, Including 1.2 Ethics Credits towards the annual MCLE Requirement.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Arizona CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

#### ***Arkansas***

Credits Approved: 20.5 Credits, Including 1.0 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with Nevada)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Nevada State Bar Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Arkansas CLE Board during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and complete the California Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the California CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Florida State Bar Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Florida Bar after the *Seminar* during the reporting period.

***Georgia***

Credits Approved: 17.3 Credits, Including 1.0 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the Georgia CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

***Hawaii***

Credits Approved: 20.8 Credits, Including 1.2 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with West Virginia)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect both a Uniform Certificate of Attendance and a copy of the West Virginia State Bar Notice of Accreditation at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Hawaii State Board of CLE during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

***Illinois***

Credits Approved: 15.25 Credits, Including 1.0 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Illinois Certificate of Attendance. If this certificate is not available at the registration table, please see a NACWA Staff Member. NACWA will report to Illinois' MCLE Board after the Seminar.

***Kansas***

Credits Approved: 18.5 Credits, Including 1.0 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and complete the Kansas CLE Commission Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Kansas CLE Commission after the *Seminar* and send NACWA a copy of the completed Kansas Certificate of Attendance.

***Kentucky***

They must then report directly to the Maine's Board of Overseers of the Bar during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Nevada Board of Continuing Legal Education Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the State Bar of Montana during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

***Nevada***
