Our **Green Infrastructure Grants Program** is open to communities and non-profits interested in 1) implementing water resource projects that remove stormwater from the Sewer District's combined sewer system and 2) ensuring the long-term maintenance of these practices.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Located in the combined sewer area.
- Demonstrate on-site stormwater control measures using green infrastructure.
- Applicant must demonstrate permanent control.
- Applicant must represent a Sewer District member community or a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization in the combined sewer area.
- Private, for-profit entities may not directly apply but can do so in coordination with a member community or non-profit.
- Program funding cannot be used for regulatory compliance.

GRANT FUNDING MAY INCLUDE:

- Professional services such as design and engineering costs, structural analysis, and soil testing costs
- Construction costs such as labor, materials, plants and equipment rental

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Complete applications must be received by the District no later than **December 21, 2015**.
