Dr. Ellen Gilinsky serves as Senior Policy Advisor to the Acting Assistant Administrator for Water in the Office of Water at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Prior to this appointment, she spent seven years as the Director of the Water Division at the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), where she supervised a diverse array of water quality and quantity programs. She also served for five years at DEQ as Manager of the Office of Wetlands and Water Protection, helping to craft Virginia's non-tidal wetlands program.

Among her other professional accomplishments, Dr. Gilinsky was a Past President of the Association of Clean Water Administrators, held a gubernatorial appointment to the State Advisory Board of the Virginia Water Resources Research Center and was an Adjunct Faculty member at Virginia Commonwealth University in the Departments of Biology and Environmental Studies.

Dr. Gilinsky has twelve years of experience as an environmental consultant at several regional and national environmental engineering firms, focusing on water issues. She received her BA in Biology from the University of Pennsylvania and her PhD in Zoology, with a concentration in Aquatic Ecology, from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
