**Dr. Sarah Janssen** is a Senior Scientist in the Health and Environment Program at the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) in San Francisco. In her capacity as a scientist with NRDC, she provides scientific expertise for policy and regulatory decisions on a number of toxic chemicals, including hormone-disrupting substances which interfere with fertility and reproduction. Her work has included research on flame retardants, cosmetics, plastics and plasticizers, breast cancer and threats to adult reproductive health and child development.

Dr. Janssen is board-certified in preventative medicine, with a subspecialty in occupational and environmental medicine. She is an Assistant Clinical Professor at the University of California, San Francisco and is a pool physician for Kaiser Permanente of Northern California.

Dr. Janssen completed her MD and PhD in molecular and integrative physiology at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign in 2001, and her MPH at the University of California, Berkeley. She is the author of numerous peer-reviewed publications and book chapters.
