Ed McCormick is Manager of Wastewater Engineering for the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD), is responsible for EBMUD's wastewater planning, engineering, construction and information systems. He championed EBMUD's original Cogeneration Facility and its recent expansion, which allowed EBMUD to become the first utility in North America to be a net energy producer in February 2012. He has extensive capital program management experience, having performed or overseen over \$1.5 billion in wastewater, recycled water, and renewable energy capital projects during his 30+ year career in both the public and private sector of the water industry.

Mr. McCormick holds dual MS, one in Environmental Engineering from University of California Berkeley and a MPA from JFK University, in addition to a BS in Civil Engineering from the University of Massachusetts.
