Jan Zimmerman joined the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) as the Director of Finance in 2001, serving approximately 1.3 million people in the City of St. Louis and St. Louis County. MSD is the fourth largest wastewater utility in the country. St. Louis MSD is currently engaged in the first phase of a \$4.7 billion, 23 Consent Decree programs, supported, to date, by over \$1.7 billion in AA tax exempt revenue bonds. She is responsible for the District's Finance Department operations encompassing the accounts receivable function billing 425,000 customers daily, an onsite call center, procurement, budgeting and the preparation of financial statements and bond documents. She also directs the District's financial analysis, modeling and rate setting efforts.

Prior to joining MSD, Ms. Zimmerman spent seven years as the Chief Operating Officer of the St. Louis Public Schools followed by three years as a public sector consultant with PriceWaterhouseCoopers. She also has 10 years of banking experience in various financial analysis capacities.

Ms. Zimmerman has a BS in Finance from Eastern Illinois University, a MA from St. Louis University and was recently named the 2013 *Woman of Year* in the energy and utility industry by the National Association of Professional Women.
