**Scott Fulton** served from 2009 to January 2013 as General Counsel of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), where he handled or directed some of the United States' most significant environmental legal matters and represented the U.S. government at high-level international meetings and negotiations. He uses the rich experience gained from three decades of high level government service, in both Democratic and Republican administrations, to help solve complex environmental problems for clients.

In addition to his service as EPA General Counsel and an Environmental Appeals Judge, Mr. Fulton served in various other roles within EPA, including as Acting Deputy Administrator, the head of the Office of International Affairs, and a senior leader of EPA's enforcement program. He also served as Assistant Chief of the Environmental Enforcement Section of the U.S. Department of Justice Environment and Natural Resources Division. He was recognized with the two highest awards given by the U.S. government for outstanding leadership: the *Presidential Meritorious Executive Service Award*, and the *Presidential Distinguished Executive Service Award*.

Mr. Fulton attended the University of Massachusetts and holds a BA in Business Management and a JD from the University of South Carolina School of Law.
