George Hawkins is General Manager of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (DC Water). DC Water provides drinking water delivery and wastewater collection and treatment for the District of Columbia, and treats wastewater for millions in several Maryland and Virginia suburbs. The Authority operates the world's largest advanced wastewater treatment plant at Blue Plains.

Under Mr. Hawkins leadership, DC Water has launched a vast 10-year program to improve aging infrastructure and comply with ever more stringent regulatory requirements, DC Water is designing and implementing three massive environmental projects that total in excess of \$4 Billion.

Previously, Mr. Hawkins was the first director of the District Department of the Environment (DDOE). Prior, he was Executive Director of New Jersey Future, and served as Executive Director of the Stony Brook-Millstone Watershed Association. He held senior positions with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and also served Vice President Gore on the National Performance Review.

Mr. Hawkins is a member of the Bar in Massachusetts and the District of Columbia. He graduated *summa cum laude* from Princeton University and Cum Laude from Harvard Law School.
