Jeffrey Odefey is the Director of Clean Water Supply Programs for American Rivers, where he helps to lead a multi-disciplinary effort to promote integrated management of water resources through progressive regulation, sustainable financing, and policy reforms. His work focuses on urban water systems, including green infrastructure and water conservation, to preserve and protect healthy waters and communities. Formerly, he was a staff attorney for Waterkeeper Alliance and managed that organization's campaigns to address the impacts of stormwater and industrial livestock production. He also served as a staff attorney for Hudson Riverkeeper, advocating for sustainable management of New York City's drinking water supply, the largest unfiltered public water supply in the nation.

A native of Colorado, Mr. Odefey holds a BA in English and Art History from the University of Colorado, an MA from the University of Montana, and is a *magna cum laude* graduate of the Pace University School of Law.
