Primary responsibilities include oversight of subordinates' work to ensure the program is operated in compliance with state and federal regulations and the Metro District's Discharge Permit, oversight and preparation of reports for state and federal regulatory agencies, and review of routine activities of the program.

Ms. Maag is also on the Metro's District's Environmental Management System (EMS) for Biosolids work group. The EMS for Biosolids ensures that biosolids are processed appropriately and safely, and proper documentation and reporting requirements for the reuse of the product are met.
