Ray Orvin became the Executive Director of Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) in 1993. ReWa is governed by a nine member Board of Commissioners appointed by the Governor of South Carolina.

ReWa's 15 treatment Plants and 288 miles of trunk sewer provide service to the Greenville, Anderson, Laurens and Spartanburg counties of South Carolina with a customer base of 97,734.
