Terry Regnier is the Director of Anatomical Services at Mayo Clinic. He has a BS degree in Mortuary Science and worked for 13 years in funeral service before joining Mayo Clinic in 1997. He currently manages Mayo Clinic's Anatomical Bequest program, the Procedural Skills and Anatomy Laboratories, and the Bio-crematory. He helped champion legislation in 2003 for Minnesota to become the first state to recognize Alkaline Hydrolysis as a legal means of human final disposition. He assisted in the design and purchase of the first dedicated single human use Alkaline Hydrolysis machine in 2006.

Mr. Regnier has supervised over 1200 human dispositions since the machine's installation. He has been an alkaline hydrolysis topic expert presenter at the National Funeral Director Association, Minnesota Funeral Directors Association, Arrowhead Funeral Directors, and Chippewa-St. Croix Valley Wisconsin Funeral Directors meetings.
